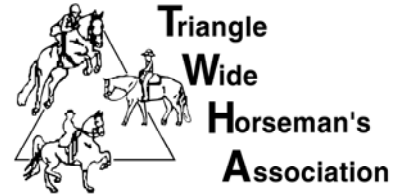

- **English classes are open to BOTH Huntseat and Saddleseat horses.**
- *Cross entry rule – There will be no cross entry between any classes marked with an asterisk *.
- All Pleasure classes require a canter or lope.
- Classes open to all horses, mules and ponies.
- Every horse on the grounds MUST have a CURRENT negative coggins. Coggins will be checked upon arrival and must be posted on stall door or at trailer (for haul-ins).
- Arabian classes open to pure & part-breeds.
- A "Novice" Rider or Horse is one having won 5 or fewer 1st places in any class in any division at any show prior to 1/1/2009. **Exceptions:** halter, 10 & Under, and classes in which there were only one entry.
- FORMAL show attire not required; however, appropriate hat (no ball caps) & boots with heel are required. Riding helmets allowed all classes.
- "Scratches" must be submitted on a "Scratch" form **at least 3 classes in advance** or the entry fee will be charged for the class!
- Each day will count as a separate show for year end points (TWAH only)
- Points from this show accepted by most Breed associated Open Show Programs including PAC & ACAAP.
- **No entries will be accepted without an open check or payment.**

High Point Awards

- **Awarded to the Champion and Reserve high point Hunt Seat, Saddleseat & Western HORSE**
- Award based on HORSE only. Multiple exhibitors may earn points on the same horse.
- Based on the 2 day total. Horse must show both days to qualify.
- Halter classes will count towards all divisions.
- Ties will be broken based on the individual placings of each horse. For example if Horse A has 2- 1st place ribbons and Horse B has only 1- 1st place then Horse A will be the winner of the tie. If they both have the same number of 1st places then the number of 2nd places will be compared, then 3rd, etc.
- The point scale used for JHR high points is a sliding scale. Note that these points are for JHR show high point awards ONLY. They are not the same as the year-end TWHA points.

Pre-Entry:

- Pre-entries save time for both office staff and exhibitors. To encourage pre-entries we will give a **\$5/horse rebate** to all entries received by Sept. 19th.
- An open check (or payment) must accompany all entries.
- All rebates will be given at the show office.
- Pre-entry is RISK FREE! You can still add/scratch classes at the show. If you can't attend simply let us know before the show begins and refunds will be given in full, less a \$10 office charge.
- You may choose to enter using our online form or by mailing in an entry form. Blank entry forms are available on our web site or by calling (252) 753-8069.

Stalls:

- Please reserve your stalls in advance if possible.
- Pre-Payment for stalls is not required.
- Stalls are **\$55** for the weekend. Please let us know who you'd like to be stalled with.
- Please let us know if you will be arriving very early or very late so we can make arrangements for your stalls and shavings to be available.

Other Fees & Information

- A grounds fee of **\$10/day** per horse will be charged for any horse on the grounds not using a stall.
- Shavings will be **\$7.00/bag**. Pre-pay for them and they will be waiting in your stalls. If you need to order shavings at the show please be prepared to pay upon their delivery.
- Camper/trailer hookups are **\$50/weekend**.
- Show grounds open Friday at 10:00 am. Stalls, shavings and the arena will be available at this time. Stalls must be vacated by noon Monday.
- Show Office will open no later than 3:00 p.m. on Friday and 7:00 a.m. Saturday & Sunday. Closing times TBA.
- There will be a **\$50** fee for all returned checks!

In order to ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable time we ask you to abide by these rules:

- **Alcoholic Beverages Prohibited.**
- Any motorized vehicle to be operated by licensed drivers ONLY.
- No ATV's or 4 Wheelers allowed on the grounds.
- No children will be unsupervised in the arenas. Absolutely no playing allowed near the arenas!
- All dogs on the grounds must be on a leash and controlled at all times. No dogs in the arenas. Vaccination records must be made available upon request.

Directions

The Eastern Ag Center is conveniently located off of Hwy 64. It is only about a 2 hour drive on an all 4-lane highway from Raleigh.

From Raleigh or Interstate 95, take 64 EAST to Williamston. Take Exit 512. It is well marked as the Ag Center Exit. At the Exit stop sign, turn left. Go 3/4 mile and the Ag. Center will be on your right. Look for the large lighted sign and lots of white fence.
