CLASS SRATCHES: MUST BE MADE IN WRITING, ON PROPER FORM IN THE SHOW OFFICE, AT LEAST 3 CLASSES IN ADVANCE OR THEY WILL BE CHARGED TO THE EXHIBITOR. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Formal show attire is NOT required. Appropriate hat (NO BALL CAPS) and boots or shoes

with heels are required. Safety helmets are appropriate and acceptable in ALL classes

FLASH OR DROPPED NOSEBAND CAVESONS ARE NOT LEGAL EQUIPMENT EXCEPT IN TRAINING CLASSES

ALL DOGS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS MUST BE KEPT ON

A LEASH. NO DOGS ALLOWED IN THE ARENA OR CAFETERIA! !

NC State Law prohibits operating any motorized vehicle (including golf carts) on the show grounds without a valid driver's license.

(Note: The above are Horse Complex rules – not TWHA or NCAHA)

PAYBACK ENTRIES: SAME HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION AS IN QUALIFYING CLASSES-must show in at least one prior class in same division, i.e. English or Western.

A NOVICE horse or rider is one having won fewer than 5 first places (open or rated shows) other than in halter classes prior to 1/1/09.

All riders 10 & under are exempt from the "novice" rule.

[1st places won in 1-horse classes do not count toward the 5 first places for either horses or riders]

*** No cross-over in classes marked with * ; horse can show in only 1 of these.**

INFORMATION FOR THE NCAHA OPEN SHOW AUGUST 29-30, 2009

LOCATION: INDOOR-HUNT COMPLEX JUST OFF I-40 ON NC STATE FAIRGROUNDS-

To be eligible to show in the 75% payback classes, entries must have shown in at least 1 other class in that division (i.e. Western or English).

Show sanctioned by Triangle-Wide Horseman's Association; TWHHA members accrue year-end award points. Points from this show accepted by NCAHA for 2009 Open Shows Awards, Arabian Horse Association OEIP Awards, 2009 Appaloosa Competitive All-Breed Activities Program (ACAAP), The American Paint Horse Association 2009 APHA Paint Alternative Competition (PAC) and 2009 NCQH Amateur Open Shows Awards. *Participants in these programs are responsible for supplying the appropriate form & getting their forms signed by show secretary.*

TRIANGLE-WIDE HORSEMAN'S ASSOCIATION RULE BOOKS & MEMBERSHIP FORMS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE SHOW OFFICE. You do not have to be a TWHHA member to show; however, all exhibitors must abide by TWHHA rules.

THERE WILL BE A \$50 FEE ON ALL RETURNED CHECKS!

Stalls (Tack & Horse): \$45 per day or \$45 for entire weekend.

A \$15.00 per day trailer grounds fee will be charged to all exhibitors who show from their trailer.

Camper fees are paid directly to the fairgrounds, first come basis. Camper fees will be collected by Fairground Security.

Shavings: \$6.00 / bag - available on the grounds Friday noon until 8 PM and Saturday morning 8 AM until noon. Other times by special advance arrangement with show management. **No move-in bedding provided.**

****Shavings must be paid for when delivered by the private contractor (Randy Pendergraft).**

Stalls must be vacated Sunday night after the show unless arrangements are made with Fairgrounds.

Stalls will be available on a first come/first served basis unless reserved in advance.

Advance stall reservations and/or requests should be made to Rory Meacham (919) 544-2817. Every effort will be made to accommodate stall requests; however, stall space is restricted by Complex management to Barns A & B (200+ stalls available). Cooperation by all exhibitors in following stall assignments will be appreciated.

ADVANCE STALL RESERVATIONS ARE NOT REQUIRED. ADVANCE ENTRIES NOT ACCEPTED.

The show office will be open on Friday night 6-8 PM for entries & will open at 7:30 AM on Saturday & Sunday.

On arrival please bring your Coggins test and horse to the barn office in front of Barn B to obtain the stamped entry form required at the show office.

COGGINS MUST BE POSTED AT STALL or you will be subject to state fine.

NO HORSES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS WITHOUT PROOF OF NEGATIVE COGGINS.
