Advance entries are not accepted.

The show office will be open on Friday night 6-8 PM for entries & will open at 7:30 AM on Saturday & Sunday.

On arrival please bring your Coggins test and horse to the barn office in front of Barn B to obtain the stamped entry form required at the show office.

"Scratches" must be submitted to the entry secretary on a "Scratch" form at least 3 classes in advance or the entry fee will be charged for the class!...No Exceptions!

"FORMAL" show attire not required; however, appropriate hat (no ball caps) & boots with heel are required. "Safety" helmets allowed in any class.

Arabian classes open to pure & part-breeds!

A "Novice" Rider or Horse is one having won 5 or fewer 1st places other than Halter in any division at any show prior to 1/1/2011. Riders 10 & under exempt. One horse classes will not count toward the 5 1st places.

Negative Coggins test required for admission to the show grounds. State requirements are that you post your negative Coggins in the provided sleeve outside the stall door. If Coggins is not visible, you may be subject to state fine.

Stalls, Shavings & Camping

Please contact Rory Meacham for Stall reservations (919) **906-3510**. If you do not make advance reservations for your stall(s) you will be assigned one upon arrival to the show grounds. **Stalls are restricted to Barns A & B Only. Please see Rory Meacham for stall assignments upon arrival to show grounds.** Advanced reservations are not required.

Stalls are a flat fee of \$50 for the weekend. Stalls are payable on your show tab. All stalls used for ANY purpose will be charged accordingly. Any one not using a stall and **showing out of your trailer will be charged a \$10.00 day fee per day.** (This is a rule imposed by the horse complex, not NCAHA.) Stalls must be vacated Sunday night after the show unless arrangements are made with Fairgrounds.

Camper fees are paid directly to the fairgrounds, first come basis. Camper fees will be collected by Fairground Security.

Shavings will be available Friday 3-8 pm and Sat. 7am to noon from the barn office. Shavings will be \$6.50/bag payable on delivery.
